



This month, I have created a video taking you through the journey of regulating and refurbishing (without replacing major action parts) a Young Chang grand piano.

After many years of use, the wooden machine within the case of a piano needs attention beyond the tuning of the strings. Pianos have close to 12,000 parts (about half as many as a car) and a good portion of those parts are located in the action (the mechanism). A piano at a school is a good example of how pianos wear. This month, I have created a video taking you through the journey of regulating and refurbishing (without replacing major action parts) a Young Chang grand piano. This piano work was done for the Hun School of Princeton and will give the school's piano a new vigor to carry out music making for a time until the action needs to be revisited.
